Psalm 110 is the most quoted psalm in the entire New Testament. After God made his covenant with David and David is anointed king by Samuel, David patiently waited for 15 years during the reign of Saul to be coronated as king in Jerusalem. Psalm 110 was likely written to celebrate the coronation and was sung at the coronation of Davidic kings thereafter. Psalm 110 clearly predicts the reign of Jesus:
