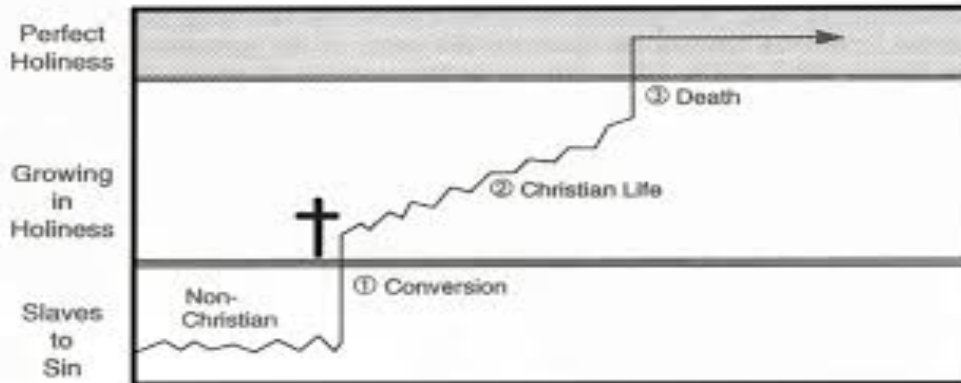

- 1.3 Sanctification is the work of man.

- “... make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue...”  
-2 Peter 1:5
- “.... work out your own salvation with fear and trembling”  
-Philippians 2:12
