When "Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Tim. 1:15) he promised his disciples that after he left the world, he would "come again" (John 14:3) so that they would always be together. The literal, bodily, return of Jesus is one of the cardinal and essential doctrines of Christianity, uniformly held by the church from the beginning until now. We are presently in the Great Wait, eagerly anticipating his return. But while we wait, we must prepare ourselves, our children, and our grandchildren for his return.
