In Acts, Luke often refers to Christianity as “the Way.” Genuine Christians are people who follow in the way of the Lord Jesus who is “the way, and the truth, and the life” (Jn. 14:6). They obey his commands regarding what to believe (doctrine) and how to behave (ethics). The Way has always been counter-cultural and faces varying degrees of opposition because it threatens the false beliefs and unloving behavior of others.
