The first commandment does not affirm the existence of other deities. There is only one true and living God (1 Cor. 8:4–6). Rather it affirms that we are prone to grant god-like status to the gifts of God and thereby neglect the Giver. When we worship the creature rather than the Creator, we dishonor God, damage ourselves and hurt the people around us (Ro. 1:25). Because we seek from these things what only God can give, these "gods" will always disappoint us.
