The eighth reason on which our joy is based is the historical fact of the first Christmas, when God came to live among us as a fully human baby. Feeling happy is in partnership with feeling loved. Our joy increases when we are cared for, just as Paul's joy increased when he received a visit from Epaphroditus who brought a tangible gift from the church at Philippi. Christmas reminds us that God visited us and brought the tangible gift of himself. When we consider Christmas and the way it highlights the unspeakable depth of God's love and care for us, we will experience greater joy. "Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!"
