Relentless Love Week 3 – We Make a Difference November 12/13, 2016

Main Point: The reason we talk about God's Relentless Love is because He came to us and He gave His life for us. Blessings come from our obedience, not our good doing.

- 1. Defining moments shape and sometimes stretch us into the person we are today. Share a defining moment in your life?
- 2. The goal in Relentless Love is to draw us so close to the heart of God -that He changes us. Do you see God changing you? How is He changing you?
- 3. How are you investing your time, talents and treasures?
- 4. Read John 14:12. What is the truth and principle Jesus is teaching us?
- 5. Read John 14:15. If we love Christ, we will do what He said to do. When you obey Christ how do you feel? If you have given your Kroger card away, share with the group the story?
- 6. Read John 21:4-12 What is the one thing the disciples did to receive the blessing of full nets of fish?
- 7. Read John 21:15-17. After each of Peter's answers, Jesus gives him three commands. What are those commands?
- 8. Peter was someone who denied and failed Jesus, but Jesus chose to restore him and not replace him. What can we learn about forgiving someone who has wronged us? How do you think this was a defining moment for Peter?
- 9. Have you had your defining moment with Christ? He still asks that question "do you love me?" If the answer is yes then be relentless in how you show His love.
- 10. This week we will be having a 24-hour prayer vigil. We will be praying for the Relentless Love movement and the people that need to be reached for Christ. Join us this Friday night from 7:00-8:00.
