Main Point - Forgive. Love. Serve. Take a next step.

- 1. If marriage begins when two people meet each other, a Christian relationship begins when a person meets Christ.
 - How did you come into a knowing relationship with Christ? Through other people? Through an invite to church?
- 2. If marriage grows by two people drawing near to one another, a Christian relationship grows by us drawing near to Christ.
 - How has drawing near to Christ helped you bridge the gap between you and Him, and thus empowering you to overcome sin issues in your life?
- Read 1 John 1:8-9. If engagement declares the intention of marriage within a relationship, making the decisions to accept God's grace and forgiveness declares the intention within a Christian relationship.
 - What areas of your life do you need to turn away from, accept God's grace and forgiveness?
- 4. If a wedding is the celebration of a relationship, **baptism is the** celebration of salvation in a Christian relationship.
 - Have you taken the next step of getting baptized? If so, what prompted you to take that next step? If not, what are your hesitations?
- 5. Just as two people continuously grow closer to one another in a relationship, we should **for the rest of our lives be growing** in our walk with Christ. Read John 13:34-35
 - As you have continuously grown closer to Christ, how have you witnessed life (transformation) change?
 - What next steps have you taken as you have been growing to Christ? Baptism? Joining a small group? Serving? Introducing people to Christ?
