The Way of Wonder Prayer August 10-13, 2023

Start Talking

Talk with your group about your view on prayer. How comfortable are you with praying?

Main Idea


We are in the "The Way of Wonder" teaching series in week two. During this series, we will journey together to personally experience the awe and wonder of God like never before. Pastor Ken encouraged us to lean in and believe that our lives will be changed over the next several weeks if we practice what we talk about. This week, Pastor Ken taught on prayer and the importance of it in our lives. We looked at a model of prayer called the "Tabernacle Prayer."

Personalize It

- 1. Read Colossians 4:2-6. What is Paul teaching the people to do in this passage? We are asked the same thing today. What is the significance of praying with an alert mind? What are your prayers often filled with? How can you make sure you are praying with a thankful heart?
- 2. There were three things Pastor Ken shared with us to help us improve our prayer life. They were: make prayer a priority, have a place, make a plan. Which of those is the hardest for you? Which would instantly change your prayer life if you committed to doing it this week?
- 3. Pastor Ken walked us through the "Tabernacle Prayer." Review the seven steps of praying through the Tabernacle. Talk through which ones you have questions about or need clarification on. Then spend time as a group praying through this together. (Scritpures connected to each step are listed in the "Key Scripture" section.)

Tabernacle Prayer model is on page two and also in the Pray Now book.

Gate- Praise and Thanskgiving
Brazen Alter- The Cross
Laver- Cleansing and Preparing
Candlestick- Holy Spirit
Table of Shewbread- The Word of God
Alter of Incense- Worship
Ark of the Covenant- Intercession



Let's Do It! Commit to a step and live it out this week!

- 1. Commit to going through the "Pray Now" book. Connect with someone from your group after finishing to share about one thing that you learned or noticed during your time.
- Join us each day for the 7 Days of Prayer at 7am at Alton Darby or on-demand at 12pm or 7pm.
- 3. Pair up with someone in your group over the next week to encourage and hold one another accountable to growing in your prayer life. Continue this practice so that it sticks and a month or more down the road, you can look back and see the change your relationship with Christ has taken because of prayer.

Let's Pray

God, thank you for who you are and what Christ did for us. You are a gracious, loving God and we are in awe of You. We each have something that we need to surrender and confess to you today, so we quietly take a moment to do that. Holy Spirit, we welcome you into our lives and into this place. 1. The Outer Courtyard... THANKSGIVING and PRAISE

Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name. For the LORD is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation.

2. The Brazen Altar... THE CROSS

Let all that I am praise the LORD; with my whole heart, I will praise his holy name. Let all that I am praise the LORD; may I never forget the good things he does for me.
