TEACHING OVERVIEW

Pastor Ken continued the teaching on the book of Philippians. This week we looked at chapter 2. The focus of this chapter is having an attitude of Christ and what that looks like for us today.

Encouragement

What was something new you learned in chapter 1, either through the teaching or through your own reading?

Did you pray the prayer Pastor Ken challenged us with last week? Did God show you anything?

Scripture & Discussion

Read: Philippians 2

Discuss

- 1. According to verses 1-5, 14-15, what are we to do as Christ followers? Does this seem possible? How can we do our part to live out what these verses say?
- 2. Pastor Ken said, "Attitude is not a skill. Attitude is a choice." Do you find it easier to let your attitude be determined by your circumstances or to choose it yourself? What do you think it would look like if you intentionally chose the attitude of Christ every day?
- 3. In verses 12-18 we read that we are to live in sacrificial obedience through serving others. In our service we experience a joy that can only come from Christ. Have you ever experienced this joy? What was it like? Do you live your life in a way to experience this joy on a regular basis?

Read: Mark 10:43-45

Discuss

4. Jesus Christ set the expectation that we are to serve and it is through our service that we find our purpose. Do you know your purpose? What kind of impact do you think you can make for Christ if you were to live this out?

5. Pastor Ken concluded the sermon by asking two questions, "what attitude are you going to choose" and "who are you going to serve?" Reflect on these two questions as a group.

Prayer

Pray as a group that each of you can have the attitude of Christ Jesus.

Pray that you can grow in your relationship with Christ daily and to be a people that serve those around you.

Next Steps

Read Philippians 2 this week and journal anything that stands out.

Do something to keep these two questions in front of you, "What attitude are you going to choose? Who are you going to serve?" Write them on a sticky note, write them on your mirror, etc.
