Defining & Pursuing Extraordinary

Main Point

God, the creator of all things, made you and that makes you EXTRAORDINARY. Love and obedience walk hand in hand with extraordinary living.

1. Describe what comes to your mind when you hear the word “extraordinary”.
2. Read Luke 12:16-21. Why were the rich man's actions in the story selfish?
3. When hearing the “then what...” story – what thoughts come to your mind? Have you ever been witness to someone's last days on this earth? Where are their thoughts and words?
4. Recognize your lineage. Read Genesis 1:27. You are extraordinary because God created you. As a kid how were you made to feel special?
5. Obedience is your choice. What does your obedience to God say about your love for Him?
6. Read Matthew 25:21-23. What Biblical, life principal, jumps out to you?
7. Read Matthew 25:25-30. What kept this servant from working like the other two? Read 1 John 4:16. What drives away fear?
8. Pastor Ken mentioned simple objects that God used to do extraordinary things. Can you name any? i.e. Shepherd's staff? He mentioned eight things. Who ever gets the most wins a prize. (not really but pretend)

9. What do you have in your hand to give God to use for His extraordinary purpose? Take your next step of obedience and watch GOD DO, what we could never do ourselves.
