Main Point: Take possession of your future by listening, responding and doing what God says.

 When you have to assemble something, do you follow the instructions? Has it ever gone badly for you when you've tried to figure it out without following the instructions? What happened? (no judging)

Recap of Joshua chapters 5-8.

- Joshua follows God's orders and first conquers Jericho, an usual way to take a city.
- Ai was the next town. It took two tries, first due to sin/ disobedience, on the second attempt God moved and blessed.
- 2. What do we learn from these passages? What are some general things that keep you from obeying God? How have you seen God work in these areas of your life?
- 3. Four thoughts pulled from Joshua chapter 8.

Walk into your future and take possession. What do you think this statement means? Read Joshua 1:3. Pastor Ken mentioned "possessions" aren't stuff. Read Galatians 5:55.

The mark on your heart is more important than any mark on your body. Read Romans 2:25-29. Read the last sentence in this passage. – What would be the "mark" today? Read John 13:35. As Christ followers, what should be our mark?

The Lord is most interested in our faithful obedience.

What step of obedience do you need to take this week? How does God speak to us?
