Get Right and Get Going

Main Point: How to live a powerful life, in this life, through the power of Christ.

1. Read Acts 1:1-11... This passage is rich in meaning and it holds the key to living the most powerful life ever: to be willing to relinquish control.
 - Why do you think it is difficult for us to give God ultimate control over our lives?
 - How have you seen God move in your life when you allowed Him to have control?
2. It is during a season of waiting when God does His greatest work. It is during this season when God builds our faith.
 - As you find yourself in a season of waiting, how have you kept your faith in God that His timing and purposes are perfect?
 - As you are waiting, how have you been making disciples, despite your current circumstances?
3. As we are waiting, we are called to be filled with God's Spirit so that we may go out, telling everyone how great He is.
 - How has your time with God effected your actions?
4. You have to learn to hear the voice of God. This can only be done through the reading of Scripture.
 - What distractions need to be eliminated in order to be in communication with God?
5. Read Isaiah 1:15-17 and James 4:3... Pastor Ken taught God does not hear our prayers if we are living in sin or if we are praying selfish prayers.
 - What would your prayer life look like if you took away you and your family?
6. There are two simple steps in order to live a powerful life: get right and get going.
 - What areas of your life need to change in order for you to get right with God?
 - How are some ways you can go and tell someone about Jesus this week?
