Main Point: Extraordinary = OTHERS FIRST. The example of Christ was abandonment of self, so the Mission may be fulfilled.

- Ask yourself this question: When it comes to opportunities for serving inside the walls of Cypress, are you more apt to say, "Yes, I will" or "No, I won't." Why?
- 2. Describe a time when someone served you in an extraordinary way, doing something for you that you absolutely did not want to do? How did that make you feel?
- 3. Philippians 2: 1-18 so powerful. Read 1-4, 5-11, 12-18; stop after each section and discuss what these scriptures are saying? Read this everyday for a week to let it become a part of you and how you think and act.
- 4. What were the two warnings, Pastor Ken pointed out, in these scriptures? Selfish _____. Vain _____.
- 5. What would it look like for you to have the attitude of Christ? Is humility viewed as a weakness in our culture? Why?
- 6. Remember the 5 layers of "others first" living. Think about where you are in the pyramid. Where would you put yourself? Draw the pyramid; work from the bottom up. This is a conversation you have with you and Jesus or your very close accountability person.
