What Are You Searching For?

Main Point: Much like those living during the days of Jesus, we all find ourselves searching for something in this life, whether it be temporary, lasting, physical, spiritual, or relational. Read Luke 24:1-12

- Place yourself in this story. You're making your way to the tomb only to find that not only is the stone rolled away, but the body is gone. Jesus isn't there. What's your initial reaction?
- According to scripture, these women in the story were the first ones to tell others about the resurrection. Who in your sphere of influence still needs to hear the story of the resurrection?
- What can we learn from the women in this story considering that the people they told didn't believe the words they were saying?

Further Actions & Readings:

- Celebrate and pray for all those who came forward this weekend to receive a strip of linen.
- Identify 1-3 people that you know still need to hear the story of the resurrection. Pray for them by name and ask God for an opportunity to share this Good News with them!
