Main Point- Five Points on how to Avoid Taking a Spiritual Vacation.

- **1.** Read Hebrews 10:22. We avoid taking a spiritual vacation by first, drawing near to God.
 - God is still speaking... in what special ways do you draw near to Him?
 - What areas of chaos in your life need to slow down in order for you to hear the voice of God?
- 2. Read Hebrews 10:23. We avoid taking a spiritual vacation by holding onto the hope.
 - Faith never stands still... How are you actively taking new steps in your faith as you hold onto the hope of Jesus?
- **3.** Read Hebrews 10:24. We avoid taking a spiritual vacation by **spurring one another on.**
 - Who are the one or two people in your life that truly know you enough to spur you on or put an arm around you?
 - > How are you nurturing those valuable relationships?
- 4. Read Hebrews 10:25. We avoid talking a spiritual vacation by **being** together.
 - God created us to need, desire, and crave relationships... In what ways in your life can you become more connected? With family? Co-workers? A service team?
- 5. Read Hebrews 10:26. We avoid taking a spiritual vacation by encouraging one another.
 - Read James 3:9-12... Our words matter! How has the way you have been living out your faith encourage or possibly discourage those around you?
