IDENTITY

Our sense of who we are as individuals; Our view of ourselves.



Few people choose their identities. Instead, they simply internalize the values of their parents or the dominant cultures (e.g., the pursuit of_materialism, power, and appearance). Sadly, these values may not be aligned with one's authentic self and create an unfulfilling life. In contrast, fulfilled people are able to live a life true to their values and pursue meaningful goals. Lack of a coherent sense of identity will lead to uncertainty about what one wants to do in life.

A person may hold multiple identities such as a teacher, father, or friend. Each position has its own meanings and expectations that are internalized as identity. A major task of self-development during early adolescence is the differentiation of multiple selves as a function of social context (e.g., self with father, mother, close friends) with an awareness of the potential contradictions.


