6 ...and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.

1 Corinthians 8:6 (niv)

--

16 For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities;

all things have been created through him and for him.

Colossians 1:16 (niv)

12 When this had dawned on him, he went to the house of Mary the mother of John, also called Mark, where many people had gathered and were praying.

Acts 12:12 (niv)

--

10 My fellow prisoner Aristarchus sends you his greetings, as does Mark, the cousin of Barnabas. (You have received instructions about him; if he comes to you, welcome him.) Colossians 4:10 (niv)

13 She who is in Babylon, chosen together with you, sends you her greetings, and so does my son Mark.

1 Peter 5:13 (niv)

1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

**2 As it is written in Isaiah the prophet, “Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way,**

**Mark 1:2 (esv)**

**3 the voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight,’ ” Mark 1:3 (esv)**

--

**GET RIGHT - reverse course!**

--

**4 John appeared, baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.**

**Mark 1:4 (esv)**

--

**5 And all the country of Judea and all Jerusalem were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins.**

**Mark 1:5 (esv)**

**6 Now John was clothed with camel’s hair and wore a leather belt around his waist and ate locusts and wild honey.**

**Mark 1:6 (esv)**

**7 And he preached, saying, “After me comes he who is mightier than I, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie.**

**8 I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”**

**9 In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.**

**Mark 1:7-9 (esv)**

**=**

**14 Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God,**

**Not good advice; but GOOD NEWS!**

**15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."**
