Preservation or deliverance from harm, ruin, or loss.
" They tried to sell it to us as economic salvation"
Deliverance from sin & its consequences through faith in Jesus as redeemer.
Luke 19:9
9 Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham.
Acts 13:47
47 For this is what the Lord has commanded us: "'I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth."
Philippians 2:12
