- Vs. 22 But the father said to his servants, 'Bring quickly the best robe, and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet.
- #5 The Father of 2nd Chances
- #6 The Father always gives the best
- Vs. 23 And bring the fattened calf and kill it, and let us eat and celebrate.
