Practical application of evangelism What is Evangelism? the preaching or promulgation of the gospel; the work of an evangelist. deliver a sermon or religious address to an assembled group of people, typically in church. publicly proclaim or teach (a religious message or belief). **promulgate:** to make known by open declaration.

What is a Testimony?

•a formal written or spoken statement, especially one given in a court of law.

- evidence or proof provided by the existence or appearance of something.
 - a public recounting of a religious conversion or experience.

What does God Word say about Testimony?

Hebrews 11:1-2

1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ² For by it the elders obtained a good testimony.

What are the differences between **Evangelism** Witnessing Testimony

All three are comparatively the same but figuratively each one presents its own value

Practical steps on how to engage your audience

Social contact and integration: In order to evangelize and witness to people we must have social contact with non-believers.

Common Ground:

We must take time to establish common ground as a bridge for communication.

(How to give away your faith by Paul little pg.57)

Get the ball rolling:

Appeal to their basic needs. Take advantage of every situation by asking questions.

Arouse interest:

Turn your conversation from social to spiritual.

(How to give away your faith by Paul little pg.60-62)

Don't go too far: some people will not allow the conversation to move toward Christ and be o.k. with it.

(How to give away your faith by Paul little pg.68-70)

Don't condemn:

It's good to let people know that their dead spiritually without Christ but it's better to show them the love of Christ and let the Holy Spirit do His job.

(How to give away your faith by Paul little pg.70-72)

Stick with the main issue: Once the ball is rolling stay on point. The central message of reconciliation with the Father must be our main focus.

Confront the person directly: don't be afraid to ask the tuff questions. If you don't get a commitment right away that's o.k. you did your job.

The invitation:


Always ask if their ready to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.


Charles Spurgeon Quote on Evangelism:


In the past six months, have Christians done any of the following ...




