1 TIMOTHY 2:9-15

DAY 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. Read 1 Timothy 2:9-15. What does Paul instruct women to clothe themselves with in verse nine?
3. What two character qualities are mentioned alongside proper clothing in verse nine? Why do you think these qualities are necessary along with proper clothing?
4. The NASB 1995 translation uses the word "discreetly" in verse nine. Look up the definition for discreet and write it below:
5. To what does Proverbs 11:22 compare a woman who lacks discretion?
6. What does Proverbs 31:25 say an excellent woman clothes herself with?
7. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper, and post it somewhere you will see it often (e.g., bathroom mirror, car, desk, kitchen sink, etc.).

4. What does Matthew 5:14-16 compare the believer to, and what should be the result of your good works? As a woman who makes a claim to godliness, what good works are you actively engaged in?

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 1 Timothy 2:9-15. What does verse eleven say?
 2. Acts 22:2 and 2 Thessalonians 3:12 use the same Greek word "quiet" that is used in the passage above. Read both verses. How would you explain the ways the word "quiet" is used? What insight does this give you into 1 Timothy 2:11?
 3. Paul also writes that a woman should receive instruction with "entire submissiveness" (NASB 1995). What is your understanding of this phrase?
