REFLECT

Read 1st Corinthians 13:4-5a

Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude.

Definitions:

Patient: Able to wait without getting annoyed or anxious

Kind: Friendly; thinks of others; doesn't hurt others

Jealous: Anger or bitterness when others do well, are liked, or have something you do not.

Boastful: Bragging about yourself; self-centered focus

Proud: A high view of your own importance; thinking of yourself as most important

Rude: Not treating others well; having bad manners towards others

5. Based on 1st Corinthians 13:4-5a says love is, are you loving? Why or why not?
