Day 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read 2 Timothy 3:14-17.

1. Begin your study time with prayer and Read Matthew 5-7.
2. This is Jesus' most famous message- the Sermon on the Mount. In your own words, what is this sermon about? (hint: see 5:48)
3. What are some key teachings that stand out to you in this message?
4. This sermon is all about kingdom living (aka living a life dedicated to Jesus). What is one truth from this sermon you can apply to your life today? Pray for help and guidance from the Lord!

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. Read John 14:16-17, 26. When Jesus leaves, who does He promise to send in His place to help guide His followers? What are some other names Jesus uses to describe this person?
