2. Collaborate together about reasons you have for trusting the Lord. Write your answers in the right gear

3. The prayer expressed in Psalm 27:8-9 is like the chain that keeps the interaction going. The question that comes in v.13 motivates the chain to keep moving. How would you answer the question that is there?

4. The results of this reciprocal exchange between the left and right gears shows up in v. 1, 3, 6, and 14. What are these and how have you seen them in your life?

5. How would you pray like that which is found in v.4 and 11?
