DAY 2

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer and read 1 John 3:1-3.

- 3. What does Philippians 3:18-19 call those who do not know Christ and how does it describe their behavior?
- 4. Nehemiah 9:28-29, Jeremiah 7:23-26, and Zechariah 7:8-12 describe God calling to the people of Israel to turn away from their sin. What is the response of the Israelites in these verses? How do you see this to be true in peoples' lives today?
- 5. What is the result for those who refuse to honor God according to Romans 1:18-32?

DAY 3

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer.and read 1 John 3:1-3.
- 2. How does the Bible describe us at the point when Christ died for us in Romans 5:6-10?
- 3. What right do we gain as a result of our salvation in John 1:12 and Ephesians 1:5, and through what means is this accomplished, according to Galatians 3:26?
- 4. What, according to Romans 8:14-16 is the evidence of our adoption as sons as daughters?
- 5. God could have redeemed us and made us servants, but instead our redemption results in our adoption as sons and daughters of the Most High God! What else does Romans 8:17 say we are? What does this mean and what insight does this give you in your relationship with God?

- 5. The verses above leave no room for grumbling or disputing. Honestly think about your own life. How much space is allowed for grumbling, complaining and disputing? Do you more closely resemble your Father in that regard, or the world?
