INTRODUCTION

- But Jesus was **BORN TO DIE!**



LESSON

True believers love one another-imperfections and all.

- **Genesis 1** | God created us in his image, to love and serve him
- **Genesis 3** | Mankind fell into sin
- **Romans 5:12** | We were all born into sin
 - Zeke - Grabbing ornaments off the tree
- **Romans 3:23** | For all have sinned and fallen short of God's Standard
- **Romans 6:23** | The wages of sin is death
- **Hebrews 2:14-15** | God became man to die for us and free us from our sin and death
- **Romans 3:22-25** | We are made right when we place our faith in Jesus Christ
