Our Creator

Day 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Genesis 1:1-3, John 1:1-3, and Psalm 104:24. How did God create the world?
2. Read Genesis 1:26-31. What do these verses teach you about what God feels toward mankind?
3. Read Genesis 1:1-2, Genesis 2:7, and Job 33:4. What was the role of the Holy Spirit in creation?
4. Read Genesis 1:28 and Colossians 1:16. Why did God create humanity?
5. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper and post it somewhere you will see it often (ex: bathroom mirror, desk, bedroom, backpack, etc)

Memory Verse:

“For by him all things were created in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities - all things were created through him and for him.”

- Colossians 1:16

Day 2

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Psalm 19:1-4, Romans 1:20, and Psalm 8:1-4. How does creation bring glory to God?
2. Read Acts 14:15-17 and Acts 17:24-29. What does creation teach us about the nature and character of God?
3. What does the diversity of creation tell you about God's imagination and creativity?
4. Read Psalm 148:7-13. In what ways does the power of God's creation encourage you or fill you with awe?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 3

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Genesis 1:26-27. What does it mean for humanity to be made in the image or likeness of God?
2. Read Colossians 1:15-20, Hebrews 1:3, and John 14:9. What does it mean for Jesus to be the perfect image of God?
3. How should that influence or inform how we act as image-bearers of God?
4. Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. Even though Genesis tells us that we are made in the image of God, what does this verse mean when it says that we are being "transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another."?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 4

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Psalm 148. How does God's command and establishment (verses 5-6) of creation give it reason to praise Him?
2. How does this Psalm demonstrate God's sovereignty over all creation?
3. Read Genesis 1:28 and Genesis 2:15. What does it mean to have dominion over or stewardship of creation?
4. What practical steps can you take to be a better steward of God's creation?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 5

1. Begin your study time with prayer. How should the knowledge that God is the creator of everything affect your daily life?
2. Knowing that God created all humans in His image, how does this affect the way that you want to treat those around you?
3. How can God's creation be a comfort to us in times of adversity or struggle?
4. Read Psalm 19:1. This psalm talks about how all of creation sings the praises of God. How can you incorporate this kind of praise into your daily life?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.
