**OVERVIEW**
BOTTOM LINE: MORALITY | RIGHT FROM WRONG?

In the Bible we read "God alone, who gave the law, is the Judge. He alone has the power to save or to destroy." In modern culture we hear "That is true for you but that is not my truth" How do we know which is true? Is God the one true judge of all things? Does he determine what is right and wrong? Can we even know? Or is there a way that both are true? This week we study the Word of God and see which worldview stands the test of truth.

**DISCUSSION****HOW DID YOU FEED YOUR SOUL?**• **TOPIC:**

- What did you learn this week about the morality?
- In what ways is morality unique to people (and not reflected in the animal kingdom)? Why do you think that is?
- In what ways is morality innate- or naturally part of humans from birth? What things do we naturally know are not okay?
- How do we know right from wrong? Who, where, or what is the measuring stick?
- When we sin who do we have to answer to?
- Read Genesis 3. When Adam sinned how did he and Eve act and respond? Why do you think they felt ashamed? Who was judging them?
- Have you ever felt ashamed of something you have done? Why? In what ways, if any, do you deal with shame now?
- What questions do you have about the Biblical morality of mankind or other worldviews regarding the morality?
- Other than biblical explanation of morality- "God is the judge of right and wrong," what are other Worldviews that explain how we get morals?

GENERAL

- While you were reading the Word of God what did you learn?
- What is something that stuck out from the reading this week?
- What is something you learned that you didn't already know?
- What questions did you have from the reading?
- What did you study, research, or talk to others about as a result of the reading?

- What claims of other worldviews of the “morality” seem to be logically **TRUE** to you? Why?
- What claims of other worldviews of the “morality” seem to be logically **FALSE** to you? Why?
- **APPLICATION:**
 - Do you believe humans or God determine right from wrong? Why? Are there any standards of biblical morality that you disagree with or that you don't see value to?
 - How does believing God determines right from wrong affect the way you live? Are there any ways you aren't living according to Biblical morality? What are they and why?
 - Do you consider yourself a moral person? In what ways do you think that matters to the Lord?
 - How has your morality- past or present- impacted your closeness to God? Do you currently feel close to or far from Him? Why do you think that is?
 - How do you think your worldview regarding Biblical morality, destiny, purpose, identity and the origin of life affects your faith? How does it impact your every day life?

HOW DID YOU FEED YOUR FLESH?

- **TOPIC:**
 - If you don't believe in the biblical account of morality
 - Why not?
 - Where do you get your morals from?
 - How do you wage war against the temptation to bend your morals according to worldly guidelines?
 - What or who currently influences your morality decisions the most? How are you impacted by friends? What you watch/listen to? Your parents?
 - What do you do when your friends cross a moral line you're convicted not to cross biblically? How does your response reflect or not reflect what you say you believe?

GENERAL

- Throughout the week, what other sins were you tempted with that the Holy Spirit is showing you need to let go of? How can we pray for you and help you stay accountable to the Holy Spirit?
- How many times did you miss reading this week? If you didn't read this week, why? What can you change?

HOW DID YOU FEED OTHERS?

- **TOPIC:**
 - As a friend to believers, how are you helping or hindering the morality of your friends who know Jesus?
 - As a friend to non-believers, how are you helping or hindering the morality of your friends who don't know Jesus?
 - Right now, how is your morality impacting your testimony and the brightness of your life as a light pointing others to Jesus?

GENERAL

- What specifically could you have done differently this week to share God's hope with someone this week?
- Did you feel stirred by the Holy Spirit to share your faith with a lost person or to encourage another believer this week and not do it? Why not?
- If you are not feeling led to share your faith or seeing chances to love others or ways to live more fully for the Lord, why do you think that is? What will you change?
- How did you encourage, teach or challenge another believer in their faith this week?

- Read your Bible every day this week
- Memorize a verse or passage that the Holy Spirit speaks to you through
- Meditate, pray, journal about what you read
