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### Day 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer. How would you describe the word lord?
  
2. According to the theme verse this week (Romans 10:9), how does one get saved? What does it mean that Jesus is Lord?
  
3. Read Matthew 28:18, Luke 6:5, Acts 10:36, & Jude 1:4. According to these verses what does Jesus have authority (aka lord) over?
  
4. Do you believe Jesus should be Lord over your life? Have you confessed Him as Lord? If yes, how does your life reflect this? If no, what questions do you have?
  
5. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper and post it somewhere you will see it often (ex: bathroom mirror, desk, bedroom, backpack, etc)

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## Day 2

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. The word LORD (in reference to Yahweh) is used in the Old Testament to refer to God, while Lord referencing Jesus is used in the New Testament by the apostles. What does this teach us about the deity (or divine nature) of Jesus?
3. Read Psalm 34:8 & 1 Peter 2:3. How have you experienced the Lord's goodness in your life?
4. Read Isaiah 8:13 & 1 Peter 3:15. Do you honor the Lord as holy in your life? Explain your answer.
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

## Day 3

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Philippians 2:1-11.
2. Amazingly, the Lord Jesus left His exalted position in heaven to come to earth and do what?
3. According to this passage, how did Jesus humble Himself during His ministry on earth? (see also Matthew 11:29 & John 13:14)
4. Does your life reflect the humility of Lord Jesus? In what ways are you humble? In what areas do you need to be more humble?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

## Day 4

1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Luke 6:46-49.
2. This is known as the Parable of the House on the Rock. What is a parable?
3. What is Jesus teaching in this parable? Would you be the wise man or the foolish man? Explain your answer.
4. According to this parable what is the proper foundation for your life? (see also James 1:22)
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

## Day 5

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. Read Revelation 17:14 & 19:16. What does it mean that Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords?
3. Read Isaiah 45:23 & Philippians 2:10-11. In the end times the Suffering servant becomes the King of kings. According to these verses, how will people respond to Jesus?
4. Read Revelation 20:11-15. What will happen to unbelievers after Jesus' Second Coming? Will your name be found in the Book of Life (Philippians 4:3, Revelation 3:5)? If not, reflect on who Jesus Christ is and ask a leader any questions.
