4. What are some of the blessings you've seen in your life lately?
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 4

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. What do we do when God's blessings don't look like we expected them to? (Psalm 6:8-10, Romans 8:28)
3. Can suffering and hardship be seen as a blessing in disguise? (Hint: James 1:2-4, Romans 5:3-5)
4. What role does faith play in experiencing God's blessings? (Hint: Ephesians 2:8-9)
5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 5

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. How can we acknowledge and give thanks for blessings? (Hint: Ephesians 1:3, Psalm 107:1, Colossians 3:17)
3. How can we use blessings that we receive to serve others? (Matthew 25:35-40, 1 Peter 4:10)
