1 TIMOTHY 3:1-7

DAY 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer.
2. Read 1 Timothy 3:1-7. In verse one, what is this office or position called?
3. Bishop, elder, and overseer can be used interchangeably, depending on your version of the Bible. In modern day, we often use the word “elder” when discussing this role. What is the first thing an elder must be in verse two?
4. Read Daniel 6:1-3. How do these verses describe Daniel?
5. For what reason do the commissioners and satraps desire to find grounds to accuse Daniel in Daniel 6:4? What is the result of their search?
6. How does the story of Daniel deepen your understanding of what it means for an elder to live “above reproach?”
