WEEK NINE

2 TIMOTHY 3:10-17

DAY 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 2 Timothy 3:10-17. In verses ten and eleven, what nine things did Paul say Timothy followed/knew of?
2. What does Paul urge us to do in Philippians 3:17, Philippians 4:9, and 1 Timothy 4:12?
3. What three cities are mentioned in verse eleven, and what did Paul endure there?
4. In Acts 13:14-43, Paul preaches in Antioch of Pisidia. What happens in Acts 13:44-51, and where do they go afterward?
5. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper, and post it somewhere you will see it often (e.g., bathroom mirror, car, desk, kitchen sink, etc.).

DAY 2

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 2 Timothy 3:10-17. What happens to Paul and Barnabas in Iconium in Acts 14:1-6, and where do they go?
2. Read Acts 14:8-20. What happens in Lystra?
3. After suffering persecution in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra, where do Paul and Barnabas go in Acts 14:21, and who does Paul meet on a later visit to Lystra in Acts 16:1-2?
4. Despite intense persecution, what do Paul and Barnabas continue to do in Acts 14:3, 7, and 21-22? In what ways does their response challenge or encourage you?
5. Write out this week's memory verse below:

DAY 3

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 2 Timothy 3:10-17. What does Paul say in 2 Timothy 3:12, and what did Jesus say in John 15:20? What are your feelings about these verses?
 2. In Acts 5:40-42, Acts 13:52, and Colossians 1:24, what is the disciples' response to being persecuted for the gospel?
 3. What do Matthew 5:10-12 and 1 Peter 4:12-13 call you to do, and why?
 4. How does the Bible call us to treat those who persecute us in Matthew 5:44-45, Romans 12:14 & 17-21, and 1 Corinthians 4:12-13?
 5. Write out this week's memory verse below:
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DAY 4

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 2 Timothy 3:10-17. What does Paul warn will happen in verse thirteen?
2. To what source does Paul attribute false doctrine in 1 Timothy 4:1?
3. How does 2 John 1:7-9 help us discern between sound doctrine and false doctrine, and what does 2 John 1:8 & 10-11 call you to do once you identify such a doctrine/teacher?
4. How does Paul encourage us to fortify ourselves against false doctrine in Ephesians 4:14-15 and 2 Timothy 3:14?
5. Write out this week's memory verse below:

DAY 5

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 2 Timothy 3:10-17. According to verse fifteen, what does the wisdom gained from Scripture lead to?
 2. How does verse sixteen describe Scripture's origin, and what is it useful for? How have you seen this to be true in your own life and in the lives of others?
 3. We are called to continuously study and learn Scripture so we can accurately handle the truth (2 Timothy 2:15). However, the intent is not to heap up knowledge for ourselves. For what purpose does 2 Timothy 3:17 say Scripture equips us? How have you seen this proven true?
