



WEEK TWELVE

1 TIMOTHY 6:17-21

DAY 1

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 1 Timothy 6:17-21. What two things does Paul caution those who are rich against doing in verse seventeen?
2. How could earthly riches lead to the temptation to become conceited? How does Jeremiah 9:23-24 speak to this temptation?
3. What does it mean to “fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches?” What warning does Proverbs 11:28 give about doing so?
4. Instead of on earthly riches, on Whom does 1 Timothy 6:17 call us to fix our hope?
5. According to James 2:5, what do the poor have the opportunity to be rich in? Why do you think this is so?
6. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper, and post it somewhere you will see it often (e.g., bathroom mirror, car, desk, kitchen sink, etc.).

DAY 2

1. Begin your study time with prayer, and read 1 Timothy 6:17-21. Paul says that God “richly supplies us with all things to enjoy.” With what, aside from money, does God richly supply us?

 3. What are we commanded to do in Deuteronomy 15:7-8?
 4. What are the blessings listed for the generous person in Deuteronomy 15:10, Psalm 37:25-26, and Proverbs 11:25?
