## BECAME MIGHTY

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### DAY 1- "...became mighty in war..."

1. Begin your study time with prayer. Read Hebrews 11:32-34. What things are listed as having been accomplished by faith?
  
2. It is impossible to exhaustively cover all of the feats accomplished by faith listed in verses 32-34. However, this week we will highlight five examples of things overcome or conquered by faith. In Joshua 10:1-5, how many kings band together to fight against Gibeon?
  
3. Gibeon had made a treaty with the Israelites. What did they want them to do in Joshua 10:6?
  
4. How does Joshua respond to this request in Joshua 10:7-9, and how does this demonstrate faith?
  
5. Read Joshua 10:10-15. What request does Joshua make of the Lord in verse twelve, and what is the end result of the battle? How does this story build your faith?
  
6. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper, and post it somewhere you will see it often (e.g. bathroom mirror, car, desk, kitchen sink, etc.).

### DAY 2- "...put foreign armies to flight..."

1. Begin your study time with prayer. How does 2 Chronicles 31:20-21 describe King Hezekiah's actions?
2. Who means to attack Judah, and what is Hezekiah's response in 2 Chronicles 32:1-8?
3. How does Sennacherib, king of Assyria, try to discourage Judah in 2 Chronicles 32:9-19? What similarities do you see between Sennacherib's words and the way the enemy seeks to discourage us in battle today?
4. How does Hezekiah respond to Sennacherib in 2 Chronicles 32:20? How is this an example for us as we face battles of varying kinds?
5. What is the result of this conflict in 2 Chronicles 32:21-23?
6. Write out this week's memory verse below:

### DAY 3- "...quenched the power of fire..."

1. Begin your study time with prayer. In Daniel 3:1-6 what was King Nebuchadnezzar's command? What was the punishment for not obeying?
  2. What charge is brought against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego in Daniel 3:7-12?
  3. The three Hebrew boys refused to worship Nebuchadnezzar's golden image. Read Daniel 3:13-18. What is their response to King Nebuchadnezzar, and how does this demonstrate faith?
  4. In Daniel 3:19-30, what happens to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego, and what is Nebuchadnezzar's response in Daniel 3:28-30?
  5. Write out this week's memory verse below:
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### DAY 4- "...shut the mouths of lions..."

1. Begin your study time with prayer. How is Daniel's character described in Daniel 6:1-5?
2. What decree does the king sign into law, and what is Daniel's response in Daniel 6:6-10? What do you think your response would have been? How do Daniel's actions challenge your faith?
3. What happens to Daniel in Daniel 6:12-17?
4. How does this story end in Daniel 6:18-28? What reason is given that Daniel was spared in verses 22-23? How does this event impact the king in verses 25-28?
5. Write out this week's memory verse below:

### DAY 5- "...escaped the edge of the sword..."

1. Begin your study time with prayer. What happens to Peter in Acts 12:1-6, and what was the church doing on his behalf?
  2. What is significant about the night in Acts 12:6, and what was Peter doing? How does this demonstrate faith?
  3. What does the angel do in Acts 12:7-11?
  4. Read the conclusion of the story in Acts 12:12-19. How do you think this story would have encouraged the church? How does it glorify God?
