Day 1

- 2. Who is Stephen? hint: see Acts 6:3-5. How is Stephen described?
- 3. What was Stephen accused of? Who came against him?

4. How does verse 15 describe Stephen's face? What does face of an angel mean? Hint: compare Exodus 34:29-30, Matthew 17:2.

5. Write out this week's memory verse on a notecard or a piece of paper and post it somewhere you will see it often (ex: bathroom mirror, desk, bedroom, backpack, etc)

Day 2

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Acts 7:1-18.
- 2. Stephen begins his speech which is a study through the Old Testament. Where was Abraham called to go? What did God promise him according to verse 5-7?
- 3. Who was sold into slavery in Egypt? Who was with him? How was God with him according to verse 10?
- 4. Read Genesis 37:17-28. Who rejected Joseph? Why did they reject him and sell him?
- 5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 3

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Acts 7:18-43.
- 2. Who was kept alive even though the Egyptian king wanted infants killed? How was this man raised?
- 3. What did Moses do when visiting Israelites? How did these men respond to Moses in verse 27-28? What happened to Moses in verse 29?
- 4. Who appeared to him at Mount Sinai? What did he accomplish according to verse 36? Who did Moses predict in verse 37?
- 5. How did the people respond to Moses in the wilderness and who did they turn to? What did the people worship instead of God?
- 6. Write out this weeks memory verse below.



Day 4

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Acts 7:44-53.
- 2. What did God ask Moses to build? What did Solomon build? Does God need a dwelling place, where does He live according to 48-50?
- 3. How does Stephen describe the council he's speaking to and the Israelites? How are these men resisting the Holy Spirit? (hint: see Matthew 12:31-32)
- 4. We see a pattern of Stephen pointing out who has been rejected in the past. Who does he accuse the Israelites of rejecting and killing in verses 52-53?
- 5. Write out this weeks memory verse below.

Day 5

- 1. Begin your study time with prayer and read Acts 7:54-60.
- 2. We see Stephen used facts of scripture for his arguments. How does the council respond to Stephen when he is done preaching truth? How is hell described in Matthew 8:11-2 and 25:30?
- 3. Who did Stephen see right before he was stoned? What did Stephen ask of the Lord in verse 60?
- 4. Read Isaiah 55:11. What does this verse say about sharing truth with others? How can this verse give you confidence when you are bold to do so?
