Psalm 62:7-8	Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.
Exodus 13:3	<ul> <li>Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why?</li> </ul>
Revelation 21:3-5	<ul> <li>If someone asked you if God was trustworthy, what would you say?</li> </ul>
	Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.
Group Values: <u>Authenticity</u> – Be honest. As you share together, learn to build trust with one another.	• Read Exodus 13:3. Share a time when you experienced God's faithfulness in the past.
	• What we worry about the most often reveals where we trust God the least. Is this true of the things you worry about? Talk about why it might be difficult for you to trust God with these things. Then, talk about one way you can trust God with those things this week.
Accountability – Give permission for others to ask you questions about your life.
