Exodus 34:5	<ul> <li>Have you ever struggled to believe that God is a loving father? Why? In what ways are you still working to see God as loving?</li> </ul>

	Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.
Group Values:	<ul> <li>Read 1 John 3:1. What does it look like to live as a child of God? What is different in your life because of this truth?</li> </ul>
<u>Authenticity</u> – Be honest. As you share together, learn to build trust with one another.	• When we receive God's love, we are able to extend God's love to others. Talk about ways you've accepted God's love and the ways you have seen His love impact those around you. How can you show His love more regularly?
Accountability - Give permission	
for others to ask you questions about your life.	Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.
<u>Safety</u> – NO gossip. However, if someone is in danger, putting someone in danger, or through their inaction causing a person to be in danger then it must be reported.	Father, Thank you for loving us. Please reveal any lies we believe about you that Keep us from fully receiving Your love. Help us to love others better this week. In Jesus Name. Amen.
	Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
