2 Timothy 4:9 Make every effort to come to me soon;


Deadline 9

•Time is short – Rome was growing impatient 'soon' - ταχέως - tachometer • Effort will be required – not convenience! Walk •Ministry is personal – 'me' 'redeeming the time' - 2x

 Luke is with me – investigative reporter • Luke – seeking account for Theophilus (Luke Acts 1) • Bring John Mark – Acts 13 – deserter! •Barnabas ministry - 'useful' - in διακονία Walk Don't give up on God's people – God is good!

Deliver 13

• Ministry needs practical stuff too! Cloak – be prepared! Books and parchments – study tools •2 Tim 2:15 – 'study to show...' Are you using the books & parchments?

14 Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm; the Lord will repay him according to his deeds.
15 Be on guard against him yourself, for he vigorously opposed our teaching.

Dispute 14,15

Alexander opposed – 'set against'
Lord is judge – we don't have to be right!
Be on your guard – Acts 20
Who is really being opposed in heresy?
How can we be 'on guard'?

We are only as strong as we are facing opposition!
