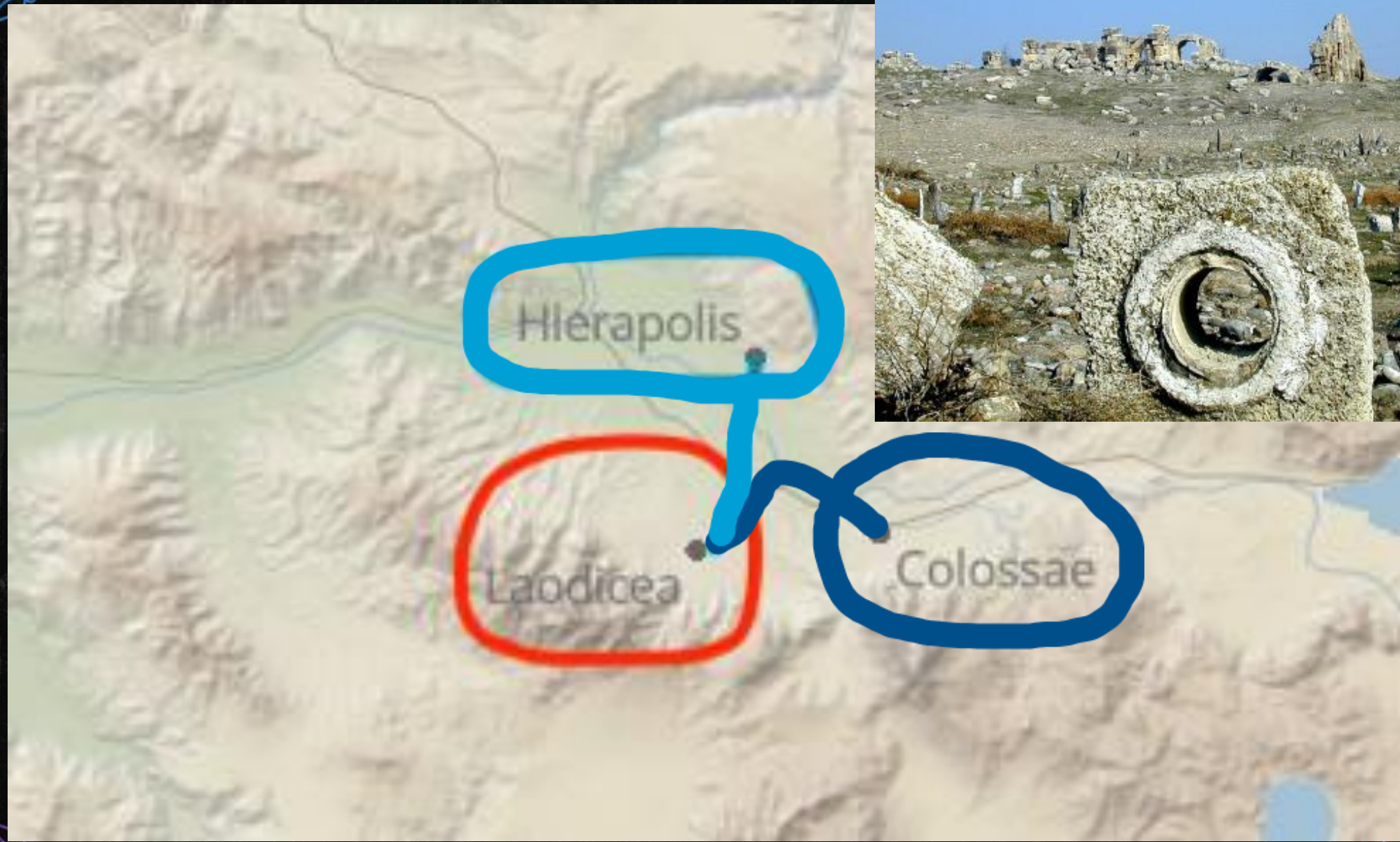
“The faithful and true witness, the beginning of God’s creation.”

19 Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent.




Reproving – showing what is wrong
