11:27 Now these are the records of the generations of Terah.


11:29 The name of Abram's wife was Sarai;

#### God's Promise Adam 11:27-32

- God's mandate to enjoy fellowship Gen 1,2
- God's judgment of sin Gen 3
- God's promise of redemption Gen 3:15
- Flood saved a remnant Gen 6-9
- Tower disperse to obey Gen 10,11
- Abram remove to bless Gen 12

1 Now the LORD said to Abram,
Go forth from your country,
And from your relatives
And from your father's house,
To the land which I will show you;

2 And I will make you a great nation, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing; 3 And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

#### God's Promise to Abram 12:1-4

- Calling of God "Go forth!"
- Separation for God "from...from"
- Promises of God "I will make..."
- Provision of God "I will bless those who..."
- Protection of God "I will curse those who..."
- Preservation of God "...all the families of the Earth..."



"Anything under God's control is never out of control." Charles R. Swindoll 4 So Abram went forth as the LORD had spoken to him; and Lot went with him. Now Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran.

5 Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his nephew, and all their possessions which they had accumulated, and the persons which they had acquired in Haran, and they set out for the land of Canaan; thus they came to the land of Canaan.

6 Abram passed through the land as far as the site of Shechem, to the oak of Moreh. Now the Canaanite was then in the land.

7 The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." So he built an altar there to the LORD who had appeared to him.

8 Then he proceeded from there to the mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to the LORD and called upon the name of the LORD.

9 Abram journeyed on, continuing toward the Negev.

#### God's Promise to World 12:5-9

- God's calling of Abram
- Abram's obedience to God ALL IN!
  - "wife" "all their possessions" Canaan = Canaanites!
- Abram claimed God's promise "built an altar" vs 7
- On to Bethel = House of God
- "built an altar" vs 8
- Abram went to the fullest 'Dan to Beersheba' = N>S
