4:7 There came a woman of Samaria to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink."

8 For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.

9 Therefore the Samaritan woman said toHim, "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask mefor a drink since I am a Samaritan woman?"(For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.)

Exception made by Jesus 7-9

- Surprising that a Jewish man like Jesus would initiate interaction with her because:
 - she was a woman
 - she was a Samaritan
 - she was of poor moral character


