## Anticipation diminishes with prosperity!

Luke 2:25-32

And there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; and this man was righteous and devout, looking for the consolation of Israel; and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

And he came in the Spirit into the Temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to carry out for Him the custom of the Law,

then he took Him into his arms, and blessed God, and said,

"Now Lord, You are releasing Your bond-servant to depart in peace, According to Your word;

For my eyes have seen Your salvation, Which You have prepared in the presence of all peoples,

A LIGHT OF REVELATION TO THE GENTILES, And the glory of Your people Israel."

Isaiah 9:2

The light will shine on them.

#### Longing for Messiah Luke 2:25-32

- Simeon not a Levite
- Believer Follower Obedient
- Longing to see –
- Saw only the beginning trusting the end!
- What do we believe in enough to act on?

## We may be looking but are we longing?

Luke 2:36-38 And there was a prophetess, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years and had lived with her husband seven years after her marriage,

and then as a widow to the age of eightyfour. She never left the temple, serving night and day with fastings and prayers.

At that very moment she came up and began giving thanks to God, and continued to speak of Him to all those who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem.

#### Looking for Messiah Luke 2:36-38

- Anna married @17? Widow 70 years 84 now
- Great loss yet had great hope
- Great pain yet had great joy
- Great dedication to worship and prayer
- What do we believe so much?

Luke 24:19-21 And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "The things about Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word in the sight of God and all the people,

and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to the sentence of death, and crucified Him."

"But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, it is the third day since these things happened."

#### Looking back for Messiah Luke 24:21

  - They knew He was crucified.
  - They knew He promised to redeem Israel.
  - They knew others had said He rose from the dead.

#### Looking back for Messiah Luke 24:21

- Emmaus men believed but now doubted
- Emmaus men hoped
- Emmaus men were anticipating gift w/o cost
- Emmaus men met the Resurrected Jesus!
- When do we have disappointments? Expectation!

Isaiah 9:6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

Gal 4:4,5
But when the fullness of the time came,
God sent forth His Son, born of a woman,
born under the Law,

so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

#### Living for Messiah Isa 9:6; Gal 4:4,5

- Savior is born
  - "For today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11
- Sovereign is come
