



1 JOHN 5:13-21



WHAT DO WE KNOW FOR SURE? Is there anything more sure than the promises of God?



"God never made a promise that was too good to be true!" D.L. Moody



14 This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.



15 And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.



16 If anyone sees his brother or sister committing a sin not leading to death, he shall ask and God will, for him, give life to those who commit sin not leading to death. There is sin leading to death; I am not saying that he should ask about that.



17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.

Walk WITH Me

God hears our prayers 14-17

He hears us
Don't mistake a slow answer for no answer!
He answers us
Go - No - Whoa - Slow!

Walk WITH Me God hears our prayers 14-17

•Sin unto death?

- Communion warning some weak, sick, dead
- What is sin? 'missing the mark'
- Motivation must be 'terror of the Lord' 2 Cor 5:11
- Compassion to see change NOT confrontation
- Not my business? 'Am I my brother's keeper?'


18 We know that no one who has been born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.

Walk WITH Me

18 We know that anyone born of God does not continue to sin; NIV 18 We know that God's children do not make a practice of sinning, NLT 18 We know that everyone who has been born of God does not keep on sinning, ESV



19 We know that we are of God, and that the whole world lies in the power of the evil one.

Walk WITH Me

- God wants us to be sure of His Word!
 John 14:1-3
- What did you see in Jesus? 60 years ago!
 What has changed? Sweeter as the years go by!



"Idol: anything between us and God."

Walk WITH Me God is true to His word 13, 20-21 • God wants us to be sure – of His Word! • Is there any substitute? NO IDOLS! • Is there any equal? NO IDOLS! • Is there any better coming along? NO IDOLS! • Is there any doubt? NO IDOLS!

Walk WITH Me

Spurgeon noted that John gave a command: *"Keep yourselves from idols"*

- This speaks against obvious, visible idols
- This speaks against worshipping yourself.
- (We can do this by overindulgence in food or drink, by laziness, or by too much concern about how they look or what they wear)
- This speaks against worshipping wealth
- This speaks against worshipping some hobby or pursuit
- This speaks against worshipping dear friends or relatives
