- 'booth' of David Tabernacle worship
- God 'with us' Shekinah glory (Ex. 40 > 2 Chron 7)
- God is absent? Ichabod (Hebrew: אִיכָבוֹד no glory, inglorious or where is the glory?) is mentioned in 1st Samuel as the son of Phinehas, a malicious priest at the biblical shrine of Shiloh, who was born on the day that the Israelites' Ark of God was taken into Philistine captivity. His mother went into labor due to the shock of hearing that her husband and Eli, her father-in-law, had died and that the Ark had been captured.

Hittites Euphrates The land promised to Abraham incorporated much more than the small sliver of land today called Israel. It includes all of Ammonites W Gaza Strip Jordan, all of Lebanon and most of Syria.

Reconquest 12

- Edom and Moab were lands of Abraham
- Nations had possessed the Promised Land
- God will allow the repossession and acquisition of Promised Lands
- The LORD is the victor recall Jericho

 - A valley in which the twelve spies obtained an enormous cluster of grapes in Numbers 13:23–24 "the brook Eshcol,"
- Blessings of Carmel the name means "the vineyard or garden of God"
