³ Once more they cried out, “*Hallelujah!* The smoke from her goes up forever & ever.”

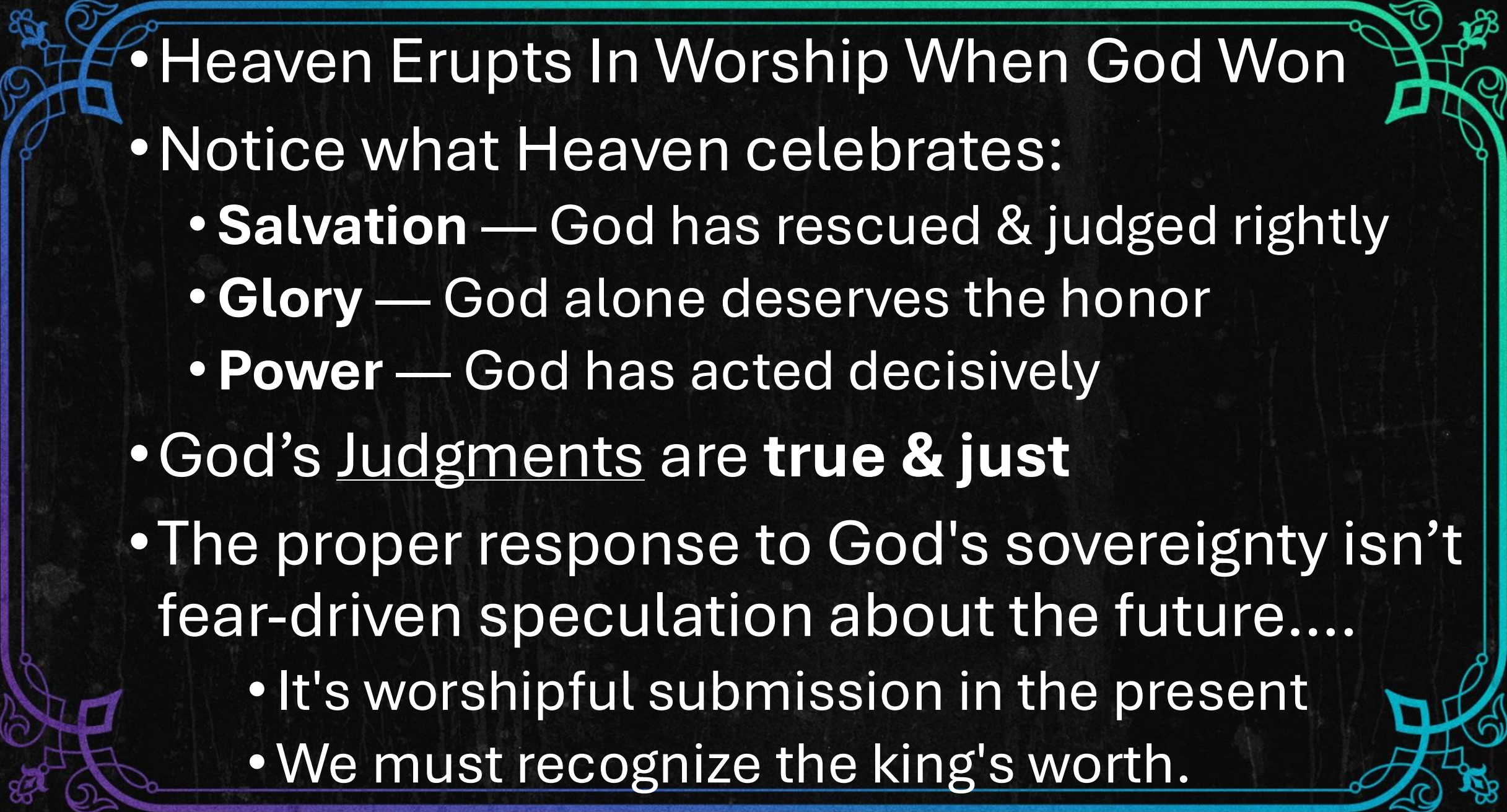
- Revelation 19:1-3

4 And the twenty-four elders & the four living creatures fell down & worshiped God Who was seated on the throne, saying, “Amen. *Hallelujah!*”

5 And from the throne came a voice saying, “Praise our God, all you His servants, you who fear Him, small & great.”

6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters & like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, “*Hallelujah!* For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns.

- Revelation 19:4-6

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- Heaven Erupts In Worship When God Won
 - Notice what Heaven celebrates:
 - **Salvation** — God has rescued & judged rightly
 - **Glory** — God alone deserves the honor
 - **Power** — God has acted decisively
 - God's Judgments are **true & just**
 - The proper response to God's sovereignty isn't fear-driven speculation about the future....
 - It's worshipful submission in the present
 - We must recognize the king's worth.

**⁷ Let us rejoice & exult & give Him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, & His Bride has made herself ready;
⁸ it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright & pure” - for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.**

- Revelation 19:7-8

⁹ And the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.” And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.”

¹⁰ Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you & your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God.” For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

- Revelation 19:9-10

- **The “Price” & Agreement:** Groom’s father negotiated the marriage. Agree upon a *mohar* (bride price)
- **The Betrothal:** The couple agree on a formal contract, the *ketubah*. They shared a cup of wine to seal the covenant.
- **The Separation:** Bride remained w/ her parents & the groom returned to his father's house to build on. *Monai* -Mansions
- **The Procession:** The groom, often accompanied by a noisy procession, would go to fetch his bride from her home.
- **The Wedding Feast:** Culminated in a massive public wedding feast could last up to seven days of food & music
- **The Consummation:** The marriage was finalized & fully sealed when the couple entered ‘mansion’ - TOGETHER

11 Then I saw heaven opened, & behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful & True, & in righteousness He judges & makes war.

12 His eyes are like a flame of fire, & on His head are many diadems, & He has a name written that no one knows but Himself.

13 He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, & the name by which He is called is The Word of God.

¹⁴ And the armies of heaven, arrayed in fine linen, white & pure, were following Him on white horses.

¹⁵ From His mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, & He will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty.

¹⁶ On His robe & on His thigh, He has a name written, King of kings & Lord of lords.

- Revelation 19:14-16

- **The King is Faithful & True - v. 11**

- White Represents Victory & Righteousness
- Jesus Is 100% Trustworthy & Unchanging
- His “Army” is Armed with White Robes

- **The King Judges Righteously - v. 11**

- Jesus Exercises His Authority Righteously

- **The King Knows His Own Identity – v.12–13**

- Jesus is not another king – He’s the Word of God.

- **The King Is King Over Every King - v. 14–16**

- All kingdoms are temporary - Jesus is ultimate

17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, & with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly directly overhead, “Come, gather for the great supper of God,

18 to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses & their riders, & the flesh of all men, both free & slave, both small & great.”

19 And I saw the beast & the kings of the earth with their armies gathered to make war against Him Who was sitting on the horse & against His army.

- Revelation 19:17-19

20 And the beast was captured, & with it the false prophet who in its presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast & those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur.

21 And the rest were slain by the sword that came from the mouth of Him who was sitting on the horse, & all the birds were gorged with their flesh.

- Revelation 19:20-21

- **Genesis 1** - *“And God said...”* - Creation
 - God Speaks & Creation Happens
- **John 1** - *“In the beginning was the Word”*
 - God Entered Creation He Spoke Into Existence
- **John 18** – Jesus of Nazareth? *“I am”* – Fell Down
 - Power was in the Word
- **John 19** – *“It is Finished!”*
 - Redemption is accomplished
- **Revelation 19** – *“His name is called The Word of God.”*
 - Now the Word returns as King.

The King Is Coming. So...

- **Worship Him**

Don't give ultimate worth to anything else.

- **Prepare for Him**

Let your life reflect that you belong to Him.

- **Follow Him**

Submit to Jesus as King.

- **Trust Him**

Live faithfully because the victory belongs to Christ.

*He isn't asking us to figure out when He's coming.
He's calling us to be ready when He comes.*



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
