Misery of the Sightless 1,2

- John 8 blasphemy = stoning!
- Blind from birth begging
- Where were the 'caregivers'?
- Rabbi Ammi: "No death w/o sin and no suffering w/o iniquity."
- •Sin real or potential? Adamic Sin?

4,5 We must work the works of Him who sent Me as long as it is day; night is coming when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the Light of the world."




6 When He had said this, He spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and applied the clay to his eyes,

Miracle of the Savior 3-7

- 'neither' not his nor his parents cause
- Messiah lame will leap & blind will see
- Suffering inspires hopelessness
- Love inspires hope!
- •Spit dust wash trust!



Mark recorded two other healings that Jesus performed with the use of His saliva (Mark 7:33 and 8:23)

"John 3:16 is not 'love is blind' – PRIDE is blind – GREED is blind – LUST is blind – not true love!"

Message of the Skeptics 8-12

- Community sees the change
- Disbelieve facts that contradict worldview
- Where is He? I went to Siloam!

19 and questioned them, saying, "Is this your son, who you say was born blind? Then how does he now see?"



9:24 So a second time they called the man who had been blind, and said to him, "Give glory to God; we know that this man is a sinner."



25 He then answered, "Whether He is a sinner, I do not know; one thing I do know, that though I was blind, now I see."
