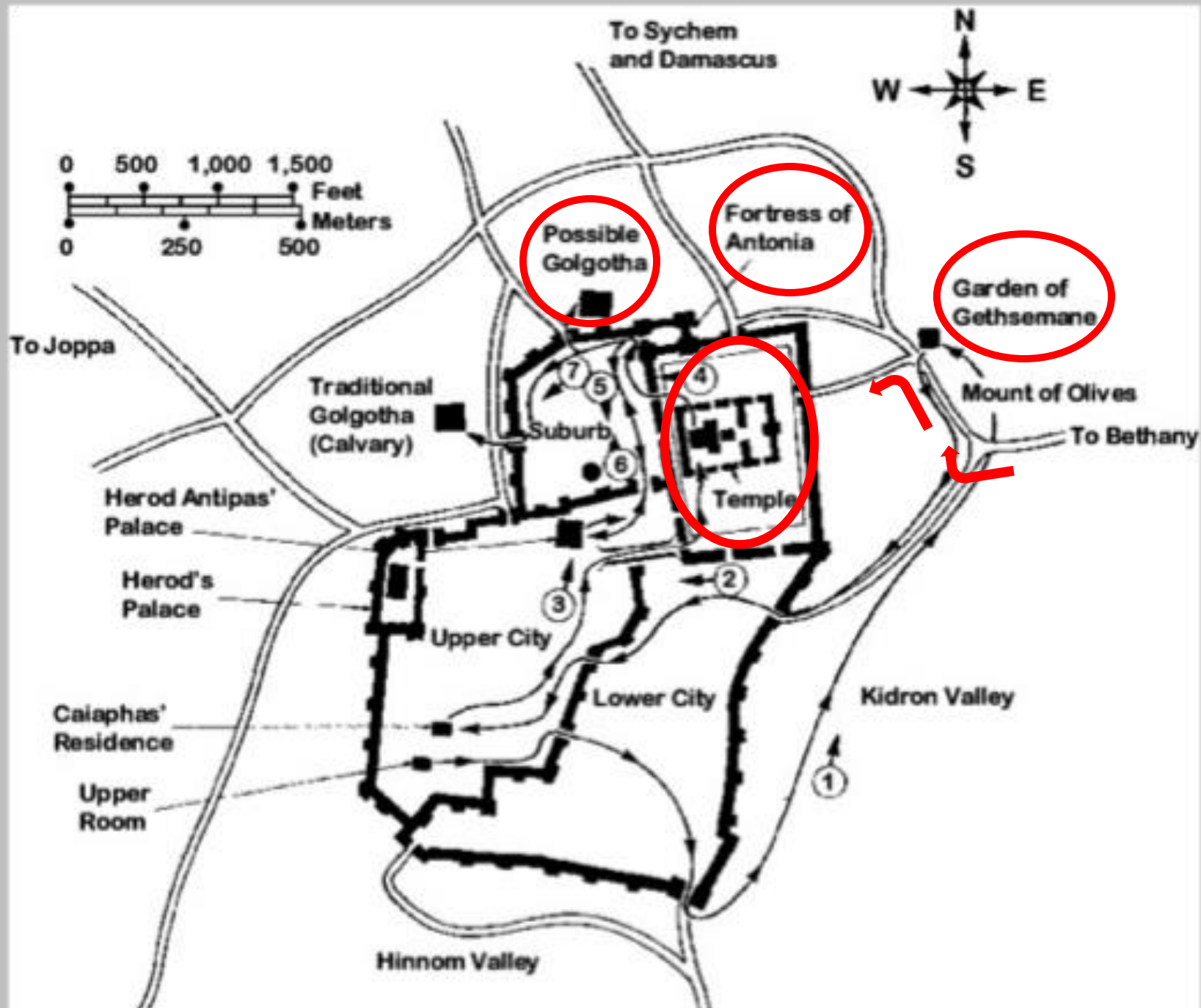

THE SERVANT: SAVING

11:1 As Jesus and his disciples approached Jerusalem, they came to the towns of Bethphage and Bethany on the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of them on ahead.



From Bethany
Around the Kidron
Into the Temple

Jesus passed by:
Gethsemane
Antonia Fortress
Sheep Gate
Altar of Sacrifice
Temple Entrance

King of Peace 1

- Jerusalem – city of Peace
- Jesus – Prince of Peace
- Jewish Feast - Passover

***“Palm Sunday is the welcome
Jesus should get every day!”***



THE SERVANT: SAVING

11:2 “Go into that village over there,” he told them. “As soon as you enter it, you will see a young donkey tied there that no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here.



THE SERVANT: SAVING

3,4 If anyone asks, 'What are you doing?' just say, 'The Lord needs it and will return it soon.'" The two disciples left and found the colt standing in the street, tied outside the front door.

5,6 As they were untying it, some bystanders demanded, “What are you doing, untying that colt?” They said what Jesus had told them to say, and they were permitted to take it.

7 Then they brought the colt to Jesus and
threw their garments over it, and he sat
on it.

THE SERVANT: SAVING

King of Promise 2-7

- Entry on a 'colt'
- Entry NOT on a war-horse!
- Entry by prophecy – Zech 9:9
- Entry as a servant

***“If we could only be
as meek as that donkey!”***



THE SERVANT: SAVING

11:7 Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their garments over it, and he sat on it.

8 Many in the crowd spread their garments on the road ahead of him, and others spread leafy branches they had cut in the fields.

9 Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting, "Praise God! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord!"

10 Blessings on the coming Kingdom of
our ancestor David! Praise God in highest
heaven!”

King of Purpose 8-10

- Saddle of clothes
- Road paved with palms & clothes
- Road crowded with supporters
- Road attended by critics – Luke 19

Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, “Teacher, rebuke Your disciples.” But Jesus answered, “I tell you, if these become silent, the stones will cry out!” **Luke 19:39,40**

***“If Jesus is not what we
expected – we are looking
for the wrong thing!”***



THE SERVANT: SAVING

11:11 So Jesus came to Jerusalem and went into the Temple. After looking around carefully at everything, he left because it was late in the afternoon. Then he returned to Bethany with the twelve disciples.

King of Purchase 11

- Jesus visits the Temple
- Jesus views the Temple
- Jesus vacates the Temple

King of Peace – Prince of Peace 1st

King of Promise – Lamb of God 1st

King of Purpose – Seek & Save 1st

King of Purchase – ‘Ransom’ 1st
