- I am the Vine



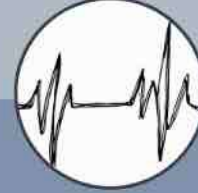

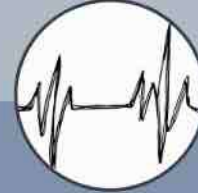
Purpose of Miracles

- Unrecorded
 - Unknown but consistent!
- Recorded
 - Seven in John
- Feeding of 5000
 - All 4 Gospels – ‘in the presence of His disciples’

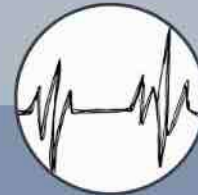


Purpose of Miracles

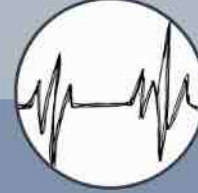
- 'in the presence of His disciples' – EYEWITNESSES
- Feeding of 5000 – public evidence

- **We do have enough for life in His name!**

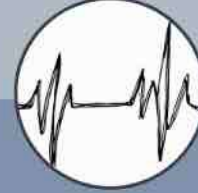

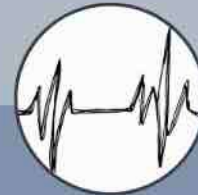

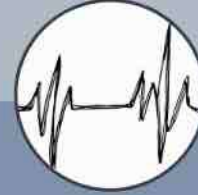
Purpose of Teachings – Nicodemus

- Jesus met with sinners

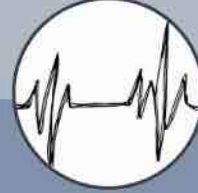


Purpose of Teachings – Nicodemus

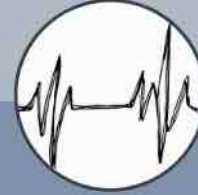
- Jesus met with small groups and individuals

- **Do we? Who do we avoid?**



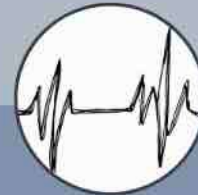

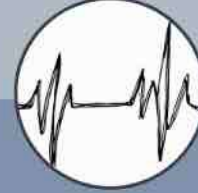

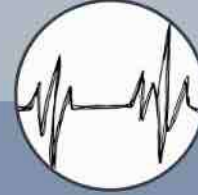
Purpose of Claims – “I AM”

- Moses was leading Israel out of bondage
- Moses was representing Jehovah

- **God wants us to have eternal life – not just a better life**

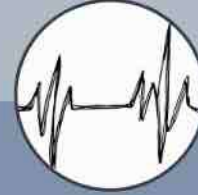


*“Miracles are illustrations

power over sin itself!**

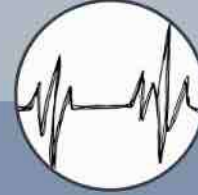


“These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.” 1 John 5:13



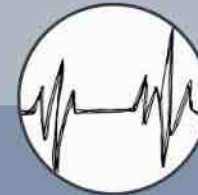
Purpose of Revelation – believe & live

- 60 Years later – John is still impressed
- John knew there was more
- John says this is enough to know & believe
- John used believe 98x as a verb – 0 as a noun!
- **This is about who you know NOT what you know**

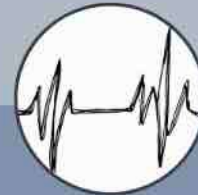


John 17:3

“This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.”

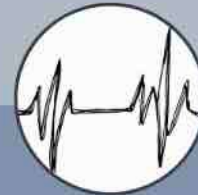


*“Miracles did not prove faith

- What do we need to believe?
 - Nicodemus came as a frightened sinner

 - Jesus showed us what He has done!

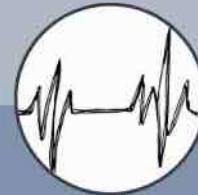


A - ADMIT OUR SIN
