# Question #1

“A Samaritan with a demon?” 48

- Answer: No, Jesus does not seek His glory! 49-50
- Despised – heart and soul! Birth and destiny
- What were the Pharisees? Honest? Righteous?
- Lesson – Do not respond in kind!

## Question #2

“Greater than Abraham?” 51-53

- Answer: Jesus glorifies his Father! 54-55
- You are a demon! Who do you think you are?
- True Worship – assigning honor due to a greater
- I cannot lie – God is my Father!
- Lesson: Your duty is to glorify God.






